- Seminole County Veteran's Treatment Court (Veterans only). Court observation, interview with coordinator and background check including fingerprints needed.
 - + Mentoring Veterans through Veteran's Court
- Christian HELP-Casselberry-online application and orientation.
 - + Working in the food pantry (9:30-12:00 or 12:00-2:30 M-F)
 - + Working job fairs (6 times a year on a Wednesday-3 shifts available)
 - If you have experience reviewing resumes or helping with interview practice, you are needed from 12:00-4:00. Lunch is provided at 11:45.
 - + Light maintenance
 - + Yard work
- Pet Rescue by Judy –Sanford. Open 7 days a week 24hrs a day-must love animals and able to handle their “accidents”. Online application and training needed for all areas.
 - + Head volunteer (need one for each of 7 days especially on the weekend)
 - + Help with Kitty Kingdom (cleaning litter boxes and making sure they have clean water and food. Early morning or later evening shifts only)
 - + Taking dogs for a walk
 - + Taking pictures of pets who are in need of adoption
 - + Sorting through donations
 - + Assisting with adoption events
 - + Assisting with laundry
 - + Adoption application screening (training needed)
- Adult Literacy League-Sanford, Lake Mary, Oviedo, Casselberry and Longwood libraries. All of the meetings are for English as a Second Language. Orientation and online application needed.
 - + One on one tutoring sessions
 - + Classroom lessons
 - + Assistance in annual Read between the Wines
 - + Data Entry

IDignity-Sanford—must sign up on line—4X a year on a Wednesday.

- + Assist individuals with obtaining IDs, Birth Certificates and Social Security Cards
- + Must be willing to stay from 7:00a.m. (orientation) to 4:00p.m. (although may not last that long) Lunch and shirts provided. Many of the jobs are seated.

Pantry Program

- + Fill client orders, organize food and stock shelves.

Thrift Store

- + Stage and organize merchandise.

Boutique

- + Stage, place higher end products in the store, assist shoppers.

Distribution Center

- + Sort, inspect and organize donations of clothes, household items and test small appliances.

Oasis

- + Greet clients, provide laundry services, assist in providing food and clean showers.

Family Volunteer Nights

- + The second Friday of every month from 5-8. Children ages 5+ with adults. Pizza and drinks are served.

Seminole County Public Schools—must sign up as a dividend, go through orientation and a background check. Serve in Pine Crest Elementary School in grades 1-5.

- + Reading Accelerated Program (RAP)-teach first graders to read-1 hour a week.*
- + Classroom teaching (can be one-on-one or for group) and would be similar to tutoring, as the teacher sees the need.
- + Mentoring is done for one hour one time a week to address grades, attendance and the child's future. Meetings take place during lunch.*
